

BISD HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER PROGRAM INFORMATION 2015

COURSES for CREDIT RECOVERY

Application: Beginning May 5, 2015, students may pick up an application on a high school campus or download it online at bryanhs.bryanisd.org Students should take the application to their academic advisor to approve the course.

Registration: Students can register and pay beginning May 25th at any high school campus. Registration is open until June 8, 2015, at Rudder High School. A limited number of seats are available. Students will be assigned to either the morning session or the afternoon session. You cannot register until you are ready to begin taking your class; we will not reserve seats. Refunds will not be issued after a student starts a course.

Dates: Summer School for Credit Recovery is **June 9 to July 1, 2015.**

Location: All classes will be held at Rudder High School. Most courses will be taught in a computer lab using the self-paced Edgenuity program with teacher support. Rudder High School is located at 3251 Austins Colony Parkway in Bryan. Their phone number is 979-209-7900.

Times: Morning session – 8:30 to 11:30 (Monday through Thursday)
Afternoon session – 12:00 to 3:00 (Monday through Thursday)

Courses: Prior approval from your academic advisor is required for all courses. You may only register for one course at a time. Upon completion of the first course, you may register and pay for a second course if time permits and seats are available.

Tuition: The regular cost of summer school is \$150 per semester course. For students on free/reduced lunch, the cost is \$75 per semester course.

Student Guidelines: Summer School for RECOVERY

- Students should report to Rudder High School (3251 Austins Colony Parkway in Bryan) in time to locate their classroom and report to class by 8:30 am (for the morning session) or 12:00 (for the afternoon session). The last day of class for credit recover is July 1, 2015.
- Because the curriculum is a self-paced program, no student will be allowed to register for more than one course at a time. If a student finishes one course and the counselor/principal believes that another course may be finished in the time left in summer school, the student may enroll in another course.
- Summer students must complete all course modules, including final exams, regardless of classification or home school rules.
- Students may, with written parent permission, drop a class. However, no refund will be made and no grade will be awarded.
- All students are expected to follow the BISD student code of conduct. Misconduct that requires a principal's action may result in a student being removed from summer school without a refund. Failure to follow summer school expectations will result in 1) warning, 2) suspension 3) removal from summer program. However, depending on the severity of the incident the principal could use discretion in immediate removal.
- Students are not allowed to loiter on the campus. Once a student leaves the classroom, that student will be expected to leave the campus or summer school consequences will be enforced. Students sitting in or standing near a vehicle in the parking lot will be considered in violation of this rule.
- Serious discipline problems may require legal action in addition to removal from summer school.
- Students who drive to school are to park in the parking lot near the tennis courts.
- BISD dress code will be followed for summer school.
- Students will be required to pay for lost or damaged books or materials.
- Personal messages will not be delivered to classrooms and visitors will not be allowed on campus unless a medical emergency arises. The principal must approve all visitors and phone messages to be delivered.
- Lockers are not available to summer school students.
