Approval of Minutes: Lori Eike motioned that the minutes be approved. Julie Crawford 2nd the motion.

Treasurer's Report: (Lori Eike) We had a deposit from Kroger Cards for \$198.57 and GBB shirts for \$2,895.22. There were some small expenses for Teacher breakfast, purchasing the ice chest for LifeSkills and Screened Images. Our ending balance is \$20,394.76
