BISD HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER PROGRAM INFORMATION 2015 COURSES for ADVANCEMENT

Application: Beginning May 5, 2015, students may pick up an application on a high school campus or download it online at bryanhs.bryanisd.org Students should take the application to their 8th grade counselor or high school academic advisor to approve the course.

- **Registration:** Students can register and pay beginning on May 18, 2015 at any high school campus. Registration is open until June 8th at Rudder High School. A limited number of seats are available. Students will be assigned to either the morning session or the afternoon session. <u>You cannot register until you are ready to begin taking your class; we will not reserve seats</u>. Refunds will not be issued after a student starts a course.
- **Dates:** Summer School for Advancement is **June 9 to July 1, 2015**.
- Location: All classes will be held at Rudder High School. Most courses will be taught in a computer lab using the self-paced Edgenuity program with teacher support. Rudder High School is located at 3251 Austins Colony Parkway in Bryan. Their phone number is 979-209-7900.
- Times:Morning session 8:30 to 11:30Afternoon session 12:00 to 3:00

Courses: Prior approval from your academic advisor is required for all courses. You may only register for one course at a time. Upon completion of the first course, you may register and pay for a second course if time permits and seats are available.

- **Tuition:** The regular cost of summer school is \$150 per semester course. For students on free/reduced lunch, the cost is \$75 per semester course. The fee for out of district students is \$150 per semester course pending the availability of seats.

Student Guidelines: Summer School for ADVANCEMENT

- Students should report to Rudder High School (3251 Austins Colony Parkway in Bryan) in time to locate their classroom and report to class by 8:30 am (for the morning session) or 12:00 (for the afternoon session). The last day of class for summer advancement is July 1, 2015.
- Because the curriculum is a self-paced program, no student will be allowed to register for more than one course at a time. If a student finishes one course and the counselor/principal believes that another course may be finished in the time left in summer school, the student may enroll in another course.
- Summer students must complete all course modules, including final exams, regardless of classification or home school rules.
- Students may, with written parent permission, drop a class. However, no refund will be made and no grade will be awarded.
- <u>All students are expected to follow the BISD student code of conduct</u>. Misconduct that requires a principal's action may result in a student being removed from summer school without a refund. Failure to follow summer school expectations will result in 1) warning, 2) suspension 3) removal from summer program.
- Students are not allowed to loiter on the campus. Once a student leaves the classroom, that student will be expected to leave the campus or summer school consequences will be enforced. Students sitting in or standing near a vehicle in the parking lot will be considered in violation of this rule.
- Serious discipline problems may require legal action in addition to removal from summer school.
- Students who drive to school are to park in the parking lot off Austins Colony Parkway near the tennis courts.
- BISD dress code will be followed for summer school.
- Students will be required to pay for lost or damaged books or materials.
- Personal messages will not be delivered to classrooms and visitors will not be allowed on campus unless a medical emergency arises. The principal must approve all visitors and phone messages to be delivered.
- Lockers are not available to summer school students.
